What medications does the State of Florida plan cover?

The Preferred Drug List is a current list of covered medications by the State of Florida plan. Medications are listed by categories or classes and are placed into cost levels known as tiers. It includes both brand and generic prescription medications. You can also find out if a medication requires prior authorization, has quantity limits and more.

Where do I fill my prescriptions?

You can choose where you fill prescriptions. Use a network pharmacy for your plan's best price. Your health plan's pharmacy network has:

- Major chains
- · Grocery store pharmacies
- Independent pharmacies
- 90-day prescriptions filled at a retail pharmacy
- · Home delivery options

Home Delivery

Your plan offers a way to get up to a 3 month supply delivered to your front door. Getting your prescriptions delivered at home can save you time and money. You choose the best home delivery option for you.

Find a network pharmacy

- Use the Optum Rx app or log in to your account to view a list of network pharmacies.
- Show your member ID card at any network retail pharmacy.
- Or, call the number on your member ID card.

Some helpful terms to know

Claim: A request from you or a provider asking the plan to pay for a medication or health service.

Coinsurance: The amount you pay for a covered prescription or service.

Deductible: The amount you pay each year before the plan starts to cover expenses.

Network pharmacy: Pharmacies that can submit claims directly to Optum Rx. Using a network pharmacy may help you save money.

Prior authorization: An approval you or your doctor obtains before you can get coverage for certain medications. The review process helps make sure the medication you're taking is appropriate and effective for your condition. Check your formulary to find out if a medication you take requires prior authorization.

Quantity limit: A limit on the amount of a medication you can get at one time. Certain medications have quantity limits for quality and safety reasons. Check your formulary to see if a medication you take has a quantity limit.
